Wolwedans Desert Academy – a vocational training centre located in the NamibRand Nature Reserve, Hardap Region - seeks to expand its training scope by adding **“Horticulture and Crop Husbandry”** to the training offering. The plan is to commence with a pilot training cycle mid 2021, seed-funded by ConTine.

**We hereby invite suitable candidates to apply for the first round of training (pilot phase) for twelve young Namibians who have “green thumbs” and horticulture at their heart.**

The basis is an eleven- month **“NTA Level 2 - Horticulture and Crop Husbandry” (Q0857)**. Upon successful completion you might be selected to continue with your 18-month NTA Level 3 programme in **“Crop and Horticulture Production” (Q0854)**. **“Animal Husbandry”** will be offered as an elective subject both in Level 2 and 3.
